## Health and Safety during PE Sessions

Dear Parents/Guardians,

I wanted to take the opportunity to outline the Weaver policy on the wearing of jewellery during PE sessions. In accordance with Cheshire East Health and Safety guidelines, the wearing of earrings, rings, bracelets and other forms of jewellery are not permitted during PE sessions.

Ideally, jewellery should be removed before your child comes to school - as this also ensures the safety of the items.

Adults in school are not permitted to help your child remove items of jewellery.

If your child has recently had his/her ears pierced, then they will be permitted to wear tape on their ears, until the 6 week period is over. However, we would actively encourage that children wait until the beginning of the summer holidays before having their ears pierced.

If your child is taking part in school swimming sessions, then earrings have to be removed regardless, as water can dislodge the tape.

Finally, it is also important that long hair is tied back during PE sessions.
