Primary College 2019

Pupils in Year 5 have been invited to take part in the Primary College initiative, organised by Cheshire College South and West, next month. This is a unique opportunity for your child to experience a wide range of fully supervised activities and to develop skills and interests in areas as yet unexplored.

Primary College 2019 will be taking place on Thursday 11 and Friday 12 July. The children will attend the college for 2 days, experiencing four different group activities alongside pupils from other local primary schools. From past experience, it proves to be a thoroughly enjoyable and educational time for staff and children alike!

Pupils will need to wear a school polo shirt and cardigan, jumper or school hoodie. They can wear their own trousers/track suit bottoms. They will also require some extra clothing if taking part in certain activities.

Sporting Activities/Dance/We Make Footballers: sports kit; T-shirt and shorts or joggers.
Brick Laying, Woodwork, Electrical Installation: old clothes and strong full shoes (not sandals or canvas shoes - school shoes are ideal).

Cooking/Love Food Hate Waste: full shoes which are flat.

Falconry: outdoor clothes.

Art and Textiles: apron/old shirt

Beauty: Head band

Creative Fun in 'The Flat': old clothes, full flat shoes and an apron.

Everyone will require a packed lunch with a drink carton and a water bottle. All belongings should be put in a named bag.

The children will be transported to and from school by coach so it is essential that they are punctual in the mornings. If you are already aware of a problem with attendance on either day during Primary College, please could you telephone school by 8:45am. The school day will run as normal so the children should be back at to Weaver by 3:10pm.

The cost of Primary College for all pupils is £10 per pupil. This will cover transport and the costs for the activities. Payment can be made online at www.parentpay.com

If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals or according to our records has been on Free School Meals for a period of 6 months since 2013, is an In Services Child or a Cared for Child then the visit may be paid for through the Pupil Premium Funds. Please indicate on your reply slip if you think this applies to you. If we don't appear to have your child on our Pupil Premium records we may need to contact you to clarify the position.
