ChECS - Cheshire East Children's Consultation Service

The Cheshire East Consultation Service (CHECS) is the 'front door' for access to services, support and advice for children and their families, from early help and support through to safeguarding and child protection.

Self-referral to ChECS

Callers will be directed to a Social Worker who will take details off the caller with regard to their concerns. The worker will gather your information and advise you of the next step.

If you need to contact someone out of hours and you believe it to be an emergency that can't wait, please call our Emergency Duty Team on 0300 123 5022.

Autism Inclusive – CEAT drop-in sessions (CEAT – Cheshire East Autism Team)

Support for autistic adults and children, those with ADHD or any other neurodiversity, as well as their families and carers. Diagnosed or suspected, all are welcome.

MORNING SUPPORT: every Wednesday morning 9.30am to 12.00pm. This group offers peer to peer support for parent/carers of those with autism, ADHD or other neurodiversities. We often have visiting professionals, to offer advice, guidance and to signpost to other key local services. Refreshments are available and young children are welcome, free to attend, no need to book. **EVENING SUPPORT**: monthly, the 4th Wednesday of each month, 6.30pm to 9.00pm. This group offers peer to peer support for those with autism, ADHD or other neurodiversities, as well as their parents/carers. Private appointments are available with Mick Rimmington – Autism Consultant and Behavioural Therapist – who can offer advice, support and strategies. Please contact Autism Inclusive via email to book a consultation with either consultant. Refreshments are available, free to attend, no need to book.
