RACE DAY DETAILS

DATE: Monday 21st July

TIME: 1:30pm (gates open from 1:15pm – please use the gate nearest the car park)

LOCATION: School field

The gate will be closed at 1:30pm. If you are arriving later than this, then please come to the main door, where a member of staff will let you through. You will then be able to access the field via the hall door. If you need to leave before the end of the race, you will need to use the door to the hall and exit via the main entrance.

Feel free to bring picnic blankets and camping chairs to sit comfortably on as you cheer on our runners and Mr Dean, who will be running a marathon around the track.

WHAT TO WEAR

An outfit that your child can safely run in. Please ensure that footwear is safe to run in.

Race for Life colours are typically pink, so feel free to add pink accessories – **wigs, tutus, funny socks or hairbands**. However, any accessories must be safe to run in.

If pink isn't available, other bright colours are welcome too!

'Back signs' can also be worn (signs that the children wear on the back of their tops, to say who they are racing for').

CHILDREN CAN COME TO SCHOOL WEARING THEIR OUTFITS



HOW FAR WILL THE CHILDREN BE RUNNING? *

- Reception – 400m (1 lap of the running track)
- Year 1- 600m (1 ½ laps of the track)
- Year 2 – 800m (2 laps)
- Year 3 – 1200m (3 laps)
- Year 4 – 1600m (4 laps)
- Year 5 – 2000m (5 laps)
- Year 6 – 2400m (6 laps)

***Please note that distances may be altered depending on the weather and a child's running ability.**

CLASSES WILL RUN IN ABOVE ORDER

TOILETS

Spectators will be able to use the toilets situated in the mobile classroom.

WATER BOTTLES

Please ensure that your child brings a water bottle with them on race day.

CAKES

The WSA have very kindly donated cup cakes for the children to eat once they have raced. Any children with intolerances etc will be catered for.

FINISHING

The whole race may finish before the end of the school day.

You will be able to take your child home once the **entire** race has finished.

Collection will be done in the normal way – via the playground.
